Dear New RC Teacher:

Welcome to the ranks of RC teachers! The following letter describes the resources available to you through Rational Island Publishers. It also summarizes some of the Guidelines that are of particular interest to teachers. A complete version of the *The 2022 Guidelines for the RC Communities*, available at our website:

Most RC print resources are available primarily in English, since this has been the language used by most of the RC Community up to now, and because RC started in an English-language country. We are involved in translating many of these resources into other languages. It is a slow process with translation being done by volunteer RC members in various communities around the world, and many languages are involved. What is available in any particular language varies greatly at this point, mostly dependent on how many native speakers of that particular language are involved in RC. The list of available translations can be found in the back of any issue of *Present* Time or here www.rc.org/translations, (organized by language).

All RC teachers who are able to read English are expected to read the pamphlet *A New Kind of Communicator*, as well as keep current with new developments in RC by reading *Present Time*. *Present Time* is published quarterly in January, April, July, and October. You can subscribe here: www.rationalisland.com by searching for *Present Time* in the search bar.

We have several other important resources for teachers.

The *RC Teacher Update* (RCTU) is a series of audio recordings of recent talks by Tim Jackins. The first 61 of the recordings are on CDs (we now have 73 recordings available). All of these recordings can now be ordered digitally or via CD. We offer a link to one of the recordings free to teachers who are being certified to teach for the first time, or who have not listened to the recordings before:

After that year we will ask you to subscribe to these audio recordings, which are produced and distributed 4 times a year, for \$20.00 USD per year. - The *RC Teacher*, issues 28, 29 and 30, contain a wealth of experience from RC teachers around the world. Issues 28 and 29 are \$3.00 each. Issue 30 is \$4.00 USD.
- **CD:** A Recent Introduction to RC (CD 13) is an audio recording of Tim Jackins giving a public introduction to RC in Seattle, Washington, USA. \$10.00 USD (also available digitally for \$6.00).

In addition, packets of new RC publications other than *Present Time*, called "**Teacher Packets**," are mailed from time to time to English-speaking RC teachers (and others who request them). These packets are the best means we have devised to ensure that all teachers and their classes are acquainted with the full breadth of new RC literature. Teacher Packets are sent out irregularly, depending on our production schedule. They have ranged in price from U.S. \$12 to U.S. \$35 and must be paid for promptly. You will be shipped and invoiced for the most recent Teacher Packet unless you decline in advance. If the packet cost is prohibitive, teachers are encouraged to sell the packet contents to their students after reading them. Reading Re-evaluation Counseling publications and exposing your students to them is an essential feature of your function as an RC teacher, though handling of the literature may be delegated to an assistant teacher or to a member of the class.

If there are special difficulties in paying for RC literature because of monetary restrictions or the local economic situation, please notify me so a solution may be found.

All teachers of RC classes are free to set their own charges for their classes. In setting the fee for their class, teachers must include, in their calculation of the fees charged for the class, a payment to the Area Outreach and Community Service Funds of Re-evaluation Counseling Community Resources, Inc. of 25% of the gross income. Three-tenths of this twenty-five percent (fifty percent for online classes) is used by Re-evaluation Counseling Community Resources, Inc. in its work of servicing the activities of the Re-evaluation Counseling Communities. Seven-tenths (fifty percent for online classes) goes to an Area Outreach Fund, which may be withdrawn for local outreach purposes on approved application signed by the Area Reference Person (ARP) (or designated teacher in a Developing Community). Details regarding class fees are found in *The 2022 Guidelines for the RC Communities*, Guidelines H.2, H.3., and H.3.A.

For classes taught outside of the USA, your Regional Reference Person (RRP) or Area Reference Person (ARP) can direct you in how to pay the outreach fund contribution. For classes taught in the USA, the 25% must be sent to RCCR, 19370 Firlands Way North, Shoreline, WA, 98133. Relevant forms and additional information on financial matters may be obtained from your ARP or RRP or may be downloaded from the RC website: www.rc.org (forms are found in the "Community" section at www.rc.org/forms).
